WHEREAS The Union, is a not-for-profit scientific organisation committed to creating a healthier world free of tuberculosis and lung disease.

WHEREAS The Union has a branch office The Union South East Asia located at C 6, Qutub Institutional Area, New Delhi 110 016, India;

WHEREAS Department of Community Medicine, Faculty of Medical Sciences, University of Sri Jayewardenepura, is a leading University in Sri Lanka where Department of Community Medicine, Faculty of Medical Sciences is a well-established centre to carry out local and international research collaborating with other countries.

WHEREAS National programme for Tuberculosis Control & Chest Diseases, Ministry of Health, Sri Lanka is a National level organization under the Ministry of Health for coordination and implementation of all TB control activities within the country. The National Program for tuberculosis and Chest diseases has identified University of Sri Jayewardenepura as a partner in carrying out research on TB and would be receiving funds from The Union.
