
About Windows movie maker


Select the videos you need

- Open Windows movie maker.
- Import the video you would like to include in your project.




How to cut/trim

- Firstly, **import** your videos into Windows Movie Maker.
- The videos will be added to the Timeline by default.




How to cut/trim

- Cut video at the target location.
- Just drag & drop the Pointer to a specific location, then click the scissor button.




How to cut/trim

- Right click on your target video, then select "Trim".
- Then you can see the trim video interface.
- You can drag and drop to set the Start Time and End Time.
- Then click Ok to save a portion of your video




How to add text


- Select TEXT/ CREDIT
- Click on the pattern you need.



- Right click on the selected pattern & select “Add to timeline”




- Type the title in the text editor book.



When you are done...

- Export edited videos to any format you want.
- You can select video format, output location, resolution, etc.
